A new maintenance facility was completed in the spring of 2020 and consists of an 8000 sq ft cold storage building and a separate 9000 sq ft building comprised of employee areas, office space, equipment repair and chemical storage/mix room.

- Perform various labor tasks as needed throughout all areas of golf course grounds
- Observe, recognize and communicate golf course conditions with an attention to detail
- Ability to learn basic equipment maintenance and repair
- Assist with a variety of winter tasks, including snow removal
- Willing and able to work long hours as needed
- Responsibilities include reading, understanding, and keeping current product labels and MSDS
- Supervise and manage teams of seasonal staff
